- Email 'save the date' to go out as well as in bulletin (Barrett to work with Steve)
- Bill and Randy will work to garner additional donations on one of the course's par 3 holes

New business:

- Still no date for the SJC Teachers/Staff Appreciation Lunch -- Bill Spartz is the Men's Club liaison for this event
- Since key board members were absent and we did not have a finance report, we decided to defer the decision on donees of Men's Club excess funds. Leading candidates are Boy Scouts, Crossroads, Caritas fund
  - We need to project cash balances at year end to determine how much is available to donate
- It was noted that a September Thursday game was added to the Bears 2012-13 schedule and we should consider having the fall Bears game outing on this night instead of a Monday in Oct or Nov
- We received a request to organize 2 Fish Fry's during Lent 2013 – the board will consider this request, but we noted that we will need someone to 'own/organize' each one if we agree
