CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP
MADE POSSIBLE BY THE SJC WOMEN'S CLUB
APPLICATION

Funds generated from the Saint John of the Cross Women's Club support a Catholic education program that awards scholarships to 8th grade and high school students of St. John of the Cross Parish with plans to attend a Catholic high school. The number of scholarships and awarded sums will be determined by the funds available and the judgment of the Scholarship Committee. The Scholarship committee will give preference to those students who demonstrate involvement in the St. John of the Cross Parish community and those with a financial need.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. The immediate family must currently be registered, active members of St. John of the Cross Parish for at least one year prior to submitting the application. Active members regularly attend Mass, volunteer time or serve in a ministry or provide regular financial support of the Parish.
2. The student should have plans for completing a Catholic high school education.
3. Financial need must be demonstrated and will be taken into serious consideration.
4. The student should have demonstrated a Christian spirit of service and participation in the parish. *A letter of recommendation is suggested and will be accepted, although not required.*
5. The student should have demonstrated scholastic achievement commensurate with his or her ability. **A copy of the most current report card is required with application.**
6. All scholarship applicants must sign an agreement to maintain confidentiality of any award received; failure to do so may result in ineligibility.
7. **Applications must be submitted between February 1-11, 2019. The final due date is February 11, 2019.**
8. The applicant will receive an email verifying that the Committee has received his or her application. If the applicant has not received an email of verification by Friday, February 15th, it is the applicant's responsibility to contact Mrs. Ginny Grecco at: fr.mcdonnellscholarship@gmail.com.
9. If awarded this scholarship, the student will be expected to give his/her time to support the major generator of funds for this scholarship by **servng at least six hours of service at the Women's Club Garage Sale in June.** Please note that future awards by the committee are contingent upon your volunteering for the Garage Sale.

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GUIDELINES

1. Notice advising that scholarship money is available will be published in the Church bulletin and be sent home to all 8th grade students in the school and Youth Catechesis program through their respective newsletters. Notice will also be available through the Director of Youth Ministry in the Parish Center office.
2. Requests for applications will be directed to the School Principal, the Assistant Principal, the Director of Youth Catechesis, the Director of Youth Ministry, the President of the SJC Women's Club and the Parish Pastor.
3. Applications must be submitted by February 11th, with a copy of a current report card. Previous applications and/or recipients may re-apply each year. Students transferring from public to Catholic high school may apply.
4. The Scholarship Committee will be chaired by the President of the SJC Women's Club and also include the School Principal, the Assistant Principal, the Director of Youth Catechesis, The YC Confirmation Coordinator, the Parish Pastor and the Director of Youth Ministry.
5. The Scholarship Committee will have the final decision on the number of scholarships, the awarded amount and the recipient(s).
6. The Scholarship Committee will notify the recipient(s) by the middle of March.
7. The awarded amount will be sent to the specified Catholic High School for the student's tuition in the Spring.
8. The name of each scholarship recipient will be kept confidential by both the Scholarship Committee and each scholarship recipient and their parents. Recipients may become ineligible for future scholarships if confidentiality is not maintained.

- Most current report card of grades must be attached.
- Attach any letters of recommendations (optional).
